



## Press Release : Fête de la Musique 2023

### Over 200 stages and music venues expected at Fête de la Musique Berlin

### The Fête de la Musique on June 21 focuses on diversity, inclusion and sustainability - many bands and artists are already confirmed!

The countdown is on - and Berlin is taking big steps towards a record-breaking **Fête de la Musique**. On Wednesday, **June 21 in 2023, summer will once again be welcomed with the city's largest free-access music event**, which this year will reach new dimensions with over 200 music venues! This year's partner district **Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg** alone has 34 participating stages, clubs, churches, initiatives, stores and garden projects in its program. For the first time, the Fête de la Musique is bringing individual concerts and the sound of music to **hospitals and nursing stations** to reach people there who are less mobile. The **Singalong** is also back: at 7 p.m., singing enthusiasts can sing the "Ode to Joy" either at the Heimathafen Neukölln together with the Chorverband Berlin or somewhere else throughout the city. The song is a symbolic reminder that the Fête is celebrated as a festival throughout Europe. Many cities throughout Germany, where the Fête is also celebrated, participate in this idea.

### Diversity and Inclusion at the Fête de la Musique Berlin

As in previous years, the Fête de la Musique in Berlin focuses on social and musical diversity and works to become an event that is as inclusive as possible. Program highlights include the **stages at the Brandenburger Tor and in the Festival Village at the Neptunbrunnen** with a program created in collaboration with the **Special Olympics World Games**. The Centre Culturel La Place and the Compagnie Antoinette Gomiz will be waiting with a hip-hop and breakdance battle at the Berlin landmark, while Graf Fidi and the Tropical Bass Collective La Byle will offer hip-hop and matching vibes at the Brandenburger Tor. The inclusive pop band Kajubayda, the children's music project Larifari, and Another Ngyuen and Gotopo will perform at the Neptunbrunnen. In collaboration with [Handiclapped - Kultur Barrierefrei e.V.](#), Fête de la Musique is also working to make concerts more inclusive and lower barriers at music venues overall.

### The Fête becomes greener!

The Fête de la Musique Berlin has already committed itself in 2021 with a Green Deal to be a pioneer in the implementation of climate goals and to make the major event ecologically and socially sustainable. The "Greener Fête de la Musique" project, launched in 2019 with **Jacob Bilabel** from the Green Music Initiative and **Dr. Birte Jung**, an expert in sustainable events, will receive structural framework conditions thanks to financial support from the Initiative Musik. Dr. Birte Jung emphasizes, *"Greener Fête is our commitment to climate responsibility. Together, we are shaping a climate-sensitive Fête de la Musique as an example of a sustainable music and culture industry."* As part of this sustainability initiative, pilot stages will be supported, among other things, in collecting data and creating climate balances to determine the status quo and define future measures for the Fête de la Musique. Sustainability goals will be defined in a "Greener Fête Charta" and a "Greener Fête Label" will also serve as a model for sustainable music stages. The project results are to be used for future-proof, sustainable cultural and music events and be transferable to other Fête de la Musique events in Europe.

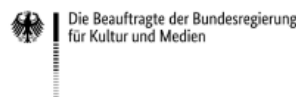
